


Setting Up Your E-mail in Mac OS X - Sierra


This tutorial shows you how to set up Mac OS X (Sierra) Mail to work with your e-mail account.

To Set Up Your E-mail Account in Mac OS X - Sierra


1. Open the Mail application on your Mac. Click **Mail** in the top menu and select **Add Account...**



2. Select **Other Mail Account** and click **Continue**



3. Enter your **Name, Email address & Password**. Click **Sign In**

- 4. If the server details are not automatically retrieved, you need to enter the following server information:

E-mail Address : Enter your e-mail address

User Name: Your email account user name

Password: Your email password

Account Type: Use the dropdown menu to select **POP**

Incoming Mail Server:

Enter your provided domain name Pop3 server address for your incoming mail server.

(E.g. your domain is yourdomain.com -> Your Pop3 Server: mail.yourdomain.com)

Outgoing mail server (SMTP) :

Enter your ISP SMTP server or Webnix SMTP server for your outgoing mail server.

a. Hong Kong (ISP) SMTP Server:

- 3. i-cable (smtp.i-cable.com)

- 7. Hutchcity (smtp.hutchcity.com)
- 8. Wharf T&T (smtp.wharftthk.com)
- 9. Pacific One Net (smtp.onebb.net)

b. Webnix SMTP Server : Same as incoming mail server (e.g. mail.yourdomain.com)

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
Advanced Setting for SMTP

The following steps are for using Webnix SMTP server only. If you choose to use your ISP SMTP server, skip this part.

Incoming Port: **110**

Outgoing Port: **6025**

5. You can change your port settings in Apple Mail by selecting **Mail > Preferences** from the Menu bar. Select your account from the sidebar of the panel that opens, then click the **Server Settings** tab. If you wish to change the preconfigured port settings, uncheck the **Automatically manage connection settings** option for both the Incoming Mail Server (POP) and Outgoing Mail Server (SMTP) sections. You can now edit the port configuration.



6. Click on the **Advanced POP Settings**, check **Allow insecure authentication** and click **OK**
7. Once everything is done. Click **Save**

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
