Setting Up Your E-mail in MS Outlook Express

This tutorial shows you how to set up Microsoft Outlook Express 6 to work with your e-mail account. This tutorial focuses on setting up Microsoft Outlook Express 6, but these settings are similar in other versions of Microsoft Outlook Express. You can set up previous versions of Microsoft Outlook Express by using the settings in this tutorial.

To Set Up Your E-mail Account in Microsoft Outlook Express

5. On the E-mail Server Names page, enter your information as follows:

My incoming mail server is a Select POP3.

Enter qm1.webnix.com or use your provided domain name Pop3 server address for your incoming mail server. (E.g. your domain is abc.com -> Your Pop3 Server: mail.abc.com)

Outgoing mail (SMTP) server

Enter your ISP SMTP server or Webnix SMTP server for your outgoing mail server.

Click Next.

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NOTE: In order to use SMTP server to send e-mails, you must first activate SMTP relay on your e-mail account. Log on to your Manage Email Accounts page to set up SMTP relay. If you do not have SMTP relay set up and your Internet Service Provider (ISP) allows it, you can use the outgoing mail server for your Internet Service Provider to get this setting.

- 13. (Optional) If you would like to keep a copy of your email messages stored on your email provider's servers, in the Delivery section, select Leave a copy of messages on server.
- 14. Tick the box, "Remove from server after 5 days" and change the day number to "2".

Your Outlook Express account is now set up. Click **Close** to close the Internet Accounts window and return to your Outlook Express.
